

Museum Pass Policy

The Shrewsbury Public library offers a variety of museum passes which provide no cost or reduced cost admittance to a variety of museums and attractions across New England. Please see the Museum Pass flier or the library website (<https://shrewsburypubliclibrary.org/services/museum-pass-program/>) for a current list of available passes.

The Museum Pass Service is based on donations from area groups, associations, and individuals. Donations to sustain current passes or add new ones are always welcome.

1. A patron must have an active CW MARS adult library card in good standing in order to reserve or check out a pass.
2. Only one pass per day may be booked per cardholder. However, when coming in to pick up the reserved pass, a patron may check out a pass to a second museum if no reserves have been placed on that second pass.
3. Each patron may have four passes on reserve at a time.
4. Each patron may book the following passes once every 90 days: Southwick's Zoo, Davis Farmland, and The New England Aquarium.
5. Patrons should have their library card in hand when checking out a museum pass.
6. Passes must be returned the day they are used, or at least before opening the next day. Passes can be returned at the main desk or in the book drop after hours.
7. Passes may be reserved online via the library website, in person, or by phone. Patrons should have their library cards available when placing such reservations.
8. Fines for overdue passes are \$10 per day per pass.
9. The museum pass service is based on cooperation of each user of the service. It is important to return passes on time so that they are available for the next patron. It is also important to cancel reservations when a pass is not needed for a booked date, so that others can make use of the pass.
