

Tabletop Games Circulation Policy

In keeping with its mission to provide diverse materials and stimulate the imagination, the library offers a collection of tabletop games both for use in the library and for circulation outside of the building. Far from the simple games of years past, today's tabletop games promote deep strategic thinking, creative problem solving, and empathy. Tabletop games are a fun and rewarding way for friends and families to enjoy time together, and the broad array of published games ensures that the library can provide games to fit everyone's tastes.

- Games may be checked out by library users with library accounts in good standing-
- Games circulate for three weeks.
- A patron may check out up to six games at a time.
- Games may not be placed on hold or renewed.
- Games may only be returned to the library's Circulation desk; they should not be placed in the book drop.

When a game is returned to the library, the Circulation Department will check its contents before returning it to its shelving location. If any parts are missing, the library will contact the patron and ask them to search for the missing parts. If enough parts are missing to render the game unplayable, or if a patron loses or damages a game, the patron will be responsible for the game's full replacement cost.
